Task 1: Current Affairs

Using websites for any one of the following newspapers- The Times, Telegraph, Guardian or Independent; Find one RECENT critical article related to <u>EDUCATION</u> (e.g. extremism in schools, ethnic differences in schools, bad behaviour in schools) and one RECENT critical article related to <u>FAMILY</u> (e.g. family breakdown, gay families, women and domestic violence).

You should create a (minimum) A4 page of analysis of each of these articles, which includes:

- ✓ A brief summary of the issues raised by the article.
- ✓ Examination of what problems exist which made writing this article necessary.
- ✓ Answer of the question: How can the issue be resolved?
- ✓ Reference sources which have helped with your analysis.

You should also be reading quality newspapers regularly (3-4 each week)! A knowledge test of current affairs will be given to you in September.
