Case studies are mentioned and statistics are used to explain answers. Uses a range of geographical terminology. Work is well written and makes sense – answers are explained using appropriate and accurate English.
<b>Green</b>	Describes some of the reasons why UK is considered more developed compared to Kenya. Identifies some differences between places using some statistics to support your answers. Gives give very basic problems facing people living in squatter settlements like Kibera in Nairobi, Kenya.	Case studies are briefly mentioned and some statistics are used. Uses some basic geographical terminology. Work is generally well written and concepts are described using appropriate English.
<b>White</b>	Gives brief answers which do not fully compare the UK and Kenya. Demonstrates a basic understanding of differences between places. Provides limited reasons why life in squatter settlements is considered to be hard.	No case studies are mentioned and statistics are not used, even when provided. Uses a very limited range of geographical terminology and use of English is not accurate.
